In memoriam

Nelly Pijnenburg

29 September 1942 - 9 March 2026

On March 9, 2026, we had to say goodbye to Nelly Pijnenburg-Klijn. Nelly was the granddaughter of Marie and Kees Klijn, who became the first owners of De Rustende Jager in 1920. In 1972, she took over the business together with her husband Jo, and Nelly became the face of De Rustende Jager. After a major renovation, the small café on the edge of the dunes grew into a renowned hospitality establishment that is still well-known throughout the region.

Those who have been visiting De Rustende Jager for a long time will surely remember her: a social woman with a consistently neat and tidy appearance, always busy attending to guests. If you had a flat tire, there was no need to call a taxi; Nelly would drive you home. She would also pick up elderly people who could no longer make it to Oude Bosschebaan on their own. Even birds and cats could always count on a bowl of food from Nelly.

She was deeply caring toward her employees. Young staff members were not allowed to cycle home alone, as it could be dangerous. Consequently, her employees would ride together across Gommelsestraat at the end of the day, or she would drive them home. Nelly was an expert at cleaning, but even then, she ensured there was a touch of conviviality. During the autumn break, when it was time for a major cleaning of the terrace, she arranged warm sausage rolls and hot chocolate with whipped cream for the staff.

Time moved on, and in 2021, Martijanne van Zon took over the reins from her aunt and uncle. Nelly could still often be found at De Rustende Jager, even as her health declined. Table 211 was her regular spot, situated exactly between the conservatory and the café. With a latte macchiato in hand, Nelly would observe everything happening around her. If she felt it was necessary, she would give the staff instructions, because indeed—Nelly saw everything.

In our thoughts, Nelly will always remain connected to De Rustende Jager. We remember her as a thoughtful woman who never let a birthday or a birth go by without sending a card. As a woman of faith who visited the local chapels during the month of May, as a caring woman, and as someone beloved by many guests. But above all, we remember her as someone with a great heart for the guests of De Rustende Jager.



For 39 years...

a large part of Martijanne's life

As a young rascal, I was allowed to go along with my parents, Sjaantje and Joost. They helped Aunt Nelly and Uncle Jo wherever they could and performed many tasks for 'our' Rustende Jager. Hospitality was in my blood from an early age; as small as I was, I was already "polishing" the terrace chairs along with them, hahaha! Initially, I was allowed to tag along mainly to get in the way during parties. As I grew a bit older, I truly helped with sanding the furniture in the winter to get everything ready again for spring. My grandfather Klijn was a forest ranger in "our" backyard. I loved it when I was allowed to join him for a ride in the jeep through the beautiful area of the Loonse and Drunense Duinen.



As I grew up and we spent Sundays visiting Grandpa and Grandma Klijn, those visits regularly resulted in a ride with Aunt Nelly back to De Rustende Jager to set out numerous coffee cups. I have seen our beautiful business grow. At first, the terrace was swept by hand, later with a push sweeper and leaf blowers. The number of chairs and tables, which were sanded in the autumn with a brush and scouring powder, steadily increased. Now, it all goes much faster with cleaning agents and the high-pressure cleaner.

And the bicycle rentals: we started with just two bikes, simply to give it a try. This quickly grew to many more. Mountain bikes were added for those wanting to race across the specially designed trails. The selection evolved into an extensive bicycle fleet, and on many weekends, De Rustende Jager serves as a meeting point for countless sporty and recreational cyclists.

At twelve, I started secondary school, and it was quickly clear to me: De Rustende Jager is my passion. It was my wish that this would one day be mine, with the support of my uncle and aunt—a dream I still pursue to this day. I completed the intermediate hotel school in three years, and from the age of 22, I began working full-time at our magnificent family business, the company of Aunt Nelly and Uncle Jo.

Over the past years, I have seen many colleagues come and go. Some grew tired of it quickly, while others stayed for years and sometimes, after a period away, still returned to Den Duin.

Together we have put in a lot of work, carried away many cups of coffee, cleaned many tables, mopped floors, cried tears of laughter and sorrow, supported each other in difficult and less pleasant times, but also laughed a lot about and with our guests. Long-term colleagues have been with us for years and ensure every single day that our Rustende Jager can open its doors to our guests. Without our staff, De Rustende Jager would not be what it is today!

I have always been happy with the help of my parents; they have always continued to support me in any way possible: helping out behind the bar or with the bikes, childcare, a listening ear. Partly because of this, I have managed to come this far.

Many lovely guests have passed through, and their stories are varied. Much joy and sorrow have been shared, and still are. It is part of our profession. Listening to people, supporting them during the loss of a loved one, taking care of them after a fall in the woods on their bike or when they were stung by a wasp. Just a few small examples of everything else that the hospitality industry entails. From daily terrace work to large parties of several hundred guests. From cleaning the many windows to loading and unloading bicycles. From steam cleaning the terrace to administrative tasks in the office. From ordering from suppliers to making the many schedules for our staff. Everything for one goal: a satisfied guest who, like so many others, returns very regularly and for years on end. That also makes for a satisfied innkeeper!

It is impossible to put into words how proud I am of our wonderful team when, on incredibly busy days, they provide our guests with their food and drinks accompanied by a smile. An unbelievable sense of satisfaction washes over me when the terrace is once again spick and span in the spring, waiting for our guests, with the windows and woodwork gleaming, ready for yet another new season.

De Rustende Jager flows through my veins.

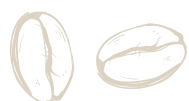

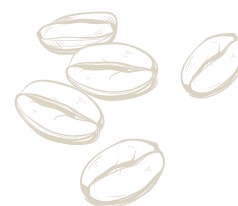

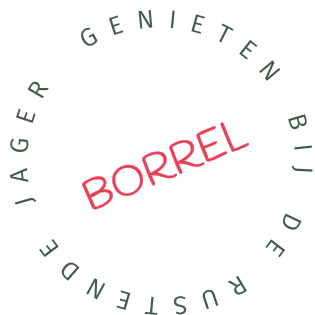

Walking through the ...

Loonse en Drunense Duinen

The Loonse en Drunense Duinen is one of the four national parks that this province boasts. During these walking routes, you will get to know this diverse area. The wooded surroundings are surprisingly interspersed with vast sand plains. Enjoy the view and the silence.



RED ROUTE

The red walking route is a beautiful, varied circular walk of approximately 3.5 km through the Loonse en Drunense Duinen. This route, also known as the Kapucijnenberg route, starts and ends at de Rustende Jager and offers a mix of hilly forest and open shifting sand plains.

COMBI ROUTE

The route is marked with narrow red arrows. After about three-quarters of the route, you can switch to the white route, marked with white arrows. Once you have completed this loop, you will return to the same point to follow the final stretch of the red route. The combined route starts and ends at De Rustende Jager.

DOG OFF-LEASH ROUTE

It's wonderful, isn't it, that your dog can frolic in the forest and the shifting sands! But please stay on the off-leash route. This way, your dog has all the freedom it needs, and nature can also take its course. Other visitors may find off-leash dogs bothersome for numerous reasons, which is why dogs must be kept on a lead in other areas.

In the Loonse en Drunense Duinen, we have two dog off-leash routes and one large area where dogs are allowed to run, play, and frolic freely. One of the off-leash routes, covering 5 km (round trip), starts and ends at De Rustende Jager. Your dog is also welcome on the other walking routes, but must be kept on a lead.

Biking through the ... Loonse en Drunense Duinen

National Park De Loonse en Drunense Duinen is, of course, also perfect for a vigorous bike ride. Whether you want to go mountain biking or prefer to traverse the dunes on an (electric) city bike, it is all possible.

MOUNTAIN BIKE TRAILS

The **green route** is over 16 kilometres long and has few elevation changes, making it ideal for beginners. The **black route** is 26 kilometres long and features quite a few differences in height, though there are options to bypass the most challenging sections.

To mountain bike in the dunes, you need a permit. If you bring your own bike and do not have one, you can purchase an annual permit from us. Discover the most beautiful cycling routes around the Loonse en Drunense Duinen.

CYCLING ROUTES

From De Rustende Jager, you cycle directly into the varied landscape of vast sand plains, forests, and heather fields. Thanks to the extensive cycle node network, you can easily compose your own route, ranging from short loops to trips of over 40 kilometres. Along the way, you can enjoy peace, nature, and pleasant stopovers. Feel free to ask us for our various route maps. You can also view the routes on our website.
